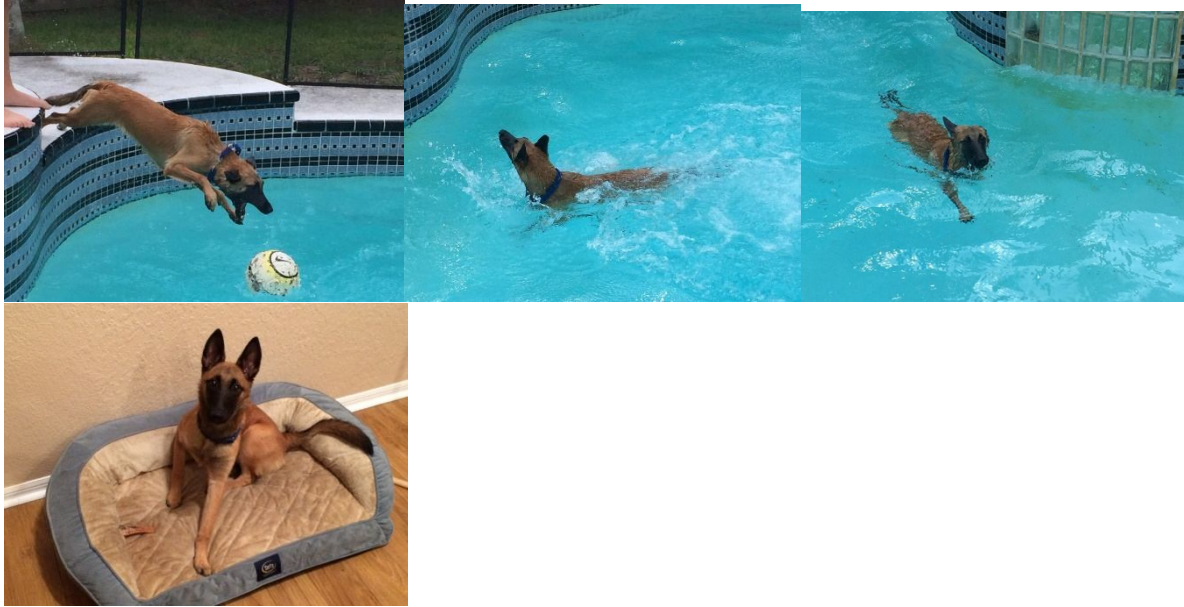


Hera (Belgian Malinois)

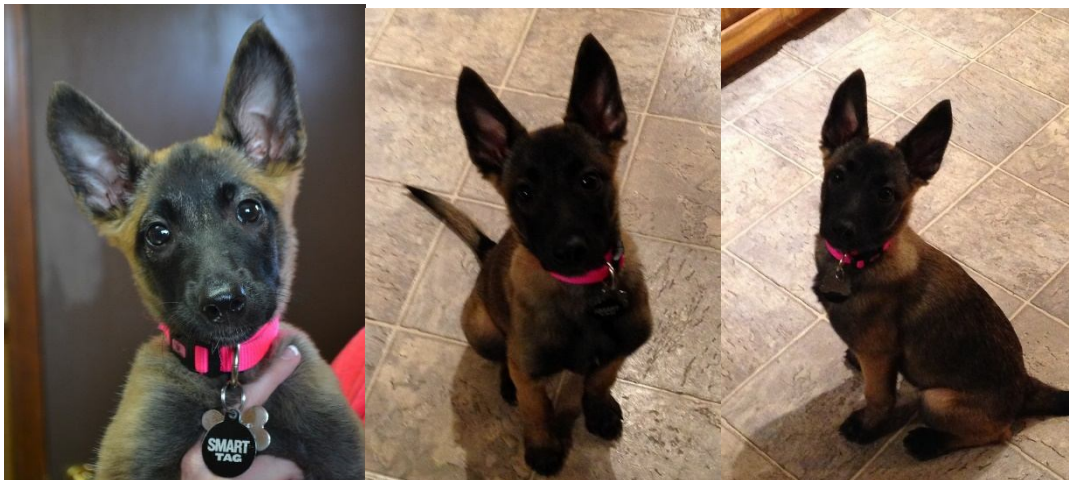


Sweet Caroline (Belgian Malinois)

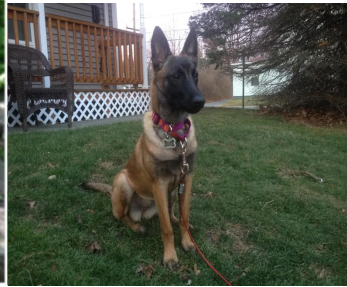

I'm am so amazed with how quick she catches onto new things. I love the quality dogs you produce. Ziva has gone through Puppy Kindergarten which she got the AKC Star Puppy Award, Jumpstart Obedience, we are just finishing Beginners Obedience and will start Advanced Obedience next week where at the end will test for CGC. Ziva is now 8months old and is 40lbs. Her little toe on the front that grew funny doesn't give her any issues. In September we started SAR Tracking/Trailing training. We attended a seminar at Camp Ripley, MN that was taught by Master Trainers from the North American Police Work Dog Association (NAPWDA). She went from being shy and timid at the beginning of the week to a high strung tugging and tracking fiend. We are currently doing tracks 150yds long and aged 2-3 minutes she does so well.
